Title: Translation of Advanced Image Analysis Tools to  
Clinical Diagnosis: Why It Has Been So Difficult?



Dr. Mori has more than 20 years of experience in the study of the human brain anatomy using advanced MRI data acquisition and analysis technologies. He especially has extensive experience in analysis of DTI and structural MRI data. He developed one of the most widely used electronic human brain atlases using multi-contrast MRI data, including various developmental stages. He is one of the pioneers of three-dimensional white matter reconstruction techniques using DTI data. His laboratory is also widely known as the creator of DtiStudio/MriStudio, which currently has more than 8,000 users worldwide.
